#### FY21 CoC Awards

- Awarded \$13,894,257 for 43 projects, including YHDP renewals
- Wellspring was awarded funding for a new 50 unit PSH project.
- No information on overall CoC score yet.
- No update on when HUD will start issuing grant agreements.
- Environmental Review
  - Be on the lookout for information about this.
  - Must be completed before HUD will issue grant agreements.

#### Unsheltered PIT Update

- 243 total people counted
  - One family of two people
  - 16 couples without children
- Thank you to all of the outreach workers who helped complete the count!
  - Family Health Centers Common Assessment Team, Nulease, Seven Counties, St.
     John Center, UP, and YMCA Safe Place Services
- Thank you to Ethan Lambert with Louisville Metro Office of Performance Improvement for all of his work on the Survey123 app.

#### CoC Board Member Recruitment

- Need to add between 6-10 CoC Board Members
- Time commitment of 6 8 meetings a year, roughly 1.5 hours each.
   Meetings are currently virtual.
- Can only add one representative from CoC funded agencies at this time.
  - Will make an exception for persons with lived experience.
- Ideally need representation from the following sectors, but it is not limited to this.
  - Department of Veterans Affairs
  - Representation from the Field of Youth Homelessness
  - Representation from the LGBTQ population.
  - Representation from JCPS/Education Field
  - Louisville Metro Housing Authority

#### CoC Board Member Recruitment, Cont.

- Must add a minimum of two individuals with lived experience.
  - One of whom must be a member of the Youth Action Board
- HUD defines persons with lived experience as someone who has experienced homelessness within the past seven years or who is a current program participant.
- The Coalition will pay persons with lived experience rate of \$50 per hour for their participation on the CoC board.
- The Coalition can provide access to a computer at our office for any board member who would need assistance attending a virtual meeting.
